

USING THE “SHINING CASTLE” CUTTING PATTERN

You need to enlarge this pattern so that each strip of five building facades is 30” wide and a bit less than 10” high. Some copy shops can create output that large; if yours can’t, have them copy it in sections and you can tape them together with wide clear tape. The tape will actually keep the pattern from tearing after multiple tracings, so it’s a good idea to tape over all lines anyway.

Make two copies of any parts with gray or patterned areas and cut these pieces out separately. The gray pieces are to be cut out of foamcore; the patterned out of white cardboard. If you don’t wish to do that, feel free to simplify – the castle should still look nice. The dotted lines on the top edge indicate where I notched the edge to look more like a castle but, again, you don’t need to.
